

Pastor's Corner

On Witnessing

Beloved Parishioners,

The last words of John the Evangelist Jn 21:25 are "This is the disciple who is bearing witness to these things and who has written these things, and we know that his testimony is true." John, in this passage, testifies to the truth of the Risen Lord and Acts 1:8 says, "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth." To be a witness is to testify that what you know is the truth and nothing but the truth. As Christians, Christ's Resurrection is the foundation of our Faith, and we believe that Jesus has Risen from the dead and by rising from the dead Jesus has conquered death. The apostles convinced of this fact gave witness even with their own lives. How can we bear witness if we do not know Christ himself? That is why we need to get close in a very profound way to be able to be a good witness.

To bear witness to the Risen Lord is to give account to what God has done in my life. It is to testify to the goodness of God in ones' life; to share the amazing story of how you may have encountered God in a way that is known to you alone. In doing so, you are not bragging or showing off, but making others see how you have been transformed by the goodness of the Lord. Giving testimony comes from a fundamental feeling of a burning desire to share the love of God in humility with other people. About two weeks ago, I was going on my normal walk in the park and a man came to me to tell about the new restaurant in town where I can enjoy a good meal with only \$14.00 and he shared the story with much excitement and asked me to go and try it. The next day when he saw me he wanted to know if I had gone because according to him it was so good and the cost reasonable. When the movie Cabrini came out someone shared the movie with us and encouraged us to go and watch it and on our staff day, the whole parish and school staff went and watched the movie. These two stories I share happened because people shared something they wanted other people to come and see and experience. This is how we are to share our story of our encounter with Jesus.

One strong way to assist in our witness to Christ is a life of conviction that Jesus is alive and that He lives in your life. The Apostles of Jesus were all devastated at the death of Jesus on the Cross. When Jesus rose from the dead and revealed Himself to them, they became empowered and went all out to bear testimony even to give their lives to Jesus. As Fulton Sheen would say, something extraordinary happened that convinced them that their Savior is alive. We need not to have seen Jesus to be convinced that He is alive.

One of the most fundamental ways to be a witness of Christ is to know Him personally. Personal encounter is the key to bearing witness. Secondly, we need to know the word of God because it is by reading the word of God that God reveals Himself more to us. That is the reason St. Jerome once said that ignorance of the Bible is the ignorance of God. When our lives are very contrary to what we proclaim our witness is questioned because if we have encountered Jesus and our life transformed then the evidence of it should be seen in our daily life. We should spend more time in prayer because in doing so the Holy Spirit is given to us to be able to face the challenges of the world we are to confront. Develop a healthy relationship with people and be as friendly as you can and through that means you can share the story of what motivates you up.

Theme: Jesus As a Good Shepherd Cares for Us

4th Sunday of Easter Year B, April 21, 2024. Good Shepherd Sunday First Reading Acts 4:8-12, Second Reading 1 John 3:1-2, Gospel John 10:11-18

Today is Good Shepherd Sunday and the day we also pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

The opening sentence in today's gospel passage is very comforting. Jesus says, "I am the Good Shepherd." A good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep. The image of the Good Shepherd manifests the various aspects of the person of Jesus. In this image we see a fierce protector who, at the cost of his own life, stands up to anybody who threatens his flock. The description of the Good Shepherd laying down his life for his sheep alludes to the servant offering his life as a sacrifice. He gives his life in exchange for our lives.

On Good Friday, He gave His life on the cross as a ransom for us. Amazingly, through the power of the Holy Spirit, God raised Him up from the dead so that we might have life through Him. For by His death and resurrection we have our life and our salvation. It is good also to note some good examples of people who have given their lives for the sake of others. A good example of this laying down one's life for others is the account of what happened in the school shooting in a high school in Florida in 2018. It was reported how one of the teachers on hearing the gun shots gathered all the students under him in one corner of the classroom and covered them with his body and the bullet caught him and killed him. None of his students was shot but his life was taken to protect the students. Why was he able to do that? It was because he was a faithful teacher, ready to take risks for his students and because of the love he has for his students. This is what the image of the Good Shepherd that we have in the person of Jesus teaches us. Even though that teacher died during that shooting, he would forever

live in the memory of these students and school for the heroic deeds of giving his life for the lives of his students. Whoever gives his life for those of others', lives forever.

Furthermore, Jesus, as a good shepherd, points to us about His faithfulness to us His sheep. He is the one we can depend on because He is faithful and trustworthy and committed to us as a good shepherd. He does not abandon us even if we abandon Him; He does not leave us alone on our own. Jesus is a faithful God in who we can trust. Jesus as a Good Shepherd shows us how much He loves us despite our limitations. Love is another aspect of Jesus as a Good Shepherd. He loves us even when we do not deserve His love as a result of our wrongdoing and shortcomings. Even at that, His love remains forever. As a good shepherd, He knows us through and through and that is why He says, "I know my sheep and mine know me." He knows us as we are and we cannot hide from Him thus, He expects openness, truthfulness, and sincerity in our approach to Him. To know someone in this sense is to be one with that person; Jesus wants us to come close to Him and be one with Him.

Finally, as a good shepherd, He wants us to listen to His voice. The only way we can listen to His voice is by obeying Him and paying attention to what He tells us. We pay attention and listen to what He tells us through the scriptures and what the church teaches us and by so doing He leads us to green pastures. Let us pray for grace to listen to His voice in our everyday events and give our lives to Him.

Happy Good Shepherd Sunday and may Our Lord, the Good Shepherd, grant you peace and love.





GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

April 21, 2024 4th Sunday of Easter

Recently I was with my little dog Libby at a retreat center in the Arizona desert. I sat in a chair near a ravine filled with shrubs. Unbeknownst to me, Libby wandered down there and disappeared. Suddenly an animal's wild shriek erupted from the area. Without thinking, I bolted down into the ravine fully expecting to see coyotes, javelinas, or rattlesnakes. I didn't care. I desperately wanted to get Libby out of there, without any self-regard. Before I could face whatever danger lay hidden, my dog blissfully trotted out from an entirely different area, utterly unaware that I had (quite heroically) just placed my life on the line.

When the adrenaline wore off, I thought to myself: how far would I have been willing to go to save her? I don't know. But I do know, if I had literally died, my friends and family would have certainly thought me insane for dying for a dog. No offense, Libby.

How passionately Jesus wants us to know him and his willingness to die for us! This week he says, "I know my own and my own know me," and "I lay down my life for the sheep." Here we encounter an insanely excessive love for us. Christianity is a relationship and not simply a religion or ethical code. In Jesus, God rescues and saves us. He laid down his life for you and me — and he has taken it up again. So often we are like Libby — blissfully ignorant of the reality of both our spiritual danger and his saving love. This Easter season, the risen Jesus calls us to be more conscious than ever before about his love. He never ceases to lay down his life for us.


