## Pastor's Corner

### Embracing His Divine Mercy

Beloved Parishioners,

This week I share reflection on Divine Mercy as this Sunday is specially devoted to embracing the Divine Mercy of God. “For the sake of His sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.” This immortal prayer of Divine Mercy devotion reminds us of the need for God’s mercy in our lives, and ties together the passion of the Lord with the Easter we celebrate. Thus, we are invited today to immerse ourselves in the ocean of divine compassion, to bask in the radiance of the risen Christ, and to be transformed by the power of His mercy.

The message of Divine Mercy Sunday is also one of hope and redemption. In the hustle and bustle of our daily lives, it’s easy to get caught up in the trials and tribulations that surround us. We may find ourselves grappling with feelings of inadequacy, guilt, or shame, weighed down by the burdens of our mistakes and shortcomings. Yet, amidst our struggles, there shines a beacon of hope – the Divine Mercy of God, which we are called to embrace. God’s mercy is not limited by our faults or failings. It knows no bounds, extending infinitely to embrace us in our brokenness and lift us with the promise of redemption. It is a mercy that meets us where we are, offering forgiveness and healing to all who seek it. However, we must note that embracing God’s mercy begins with acknowledging our need for it. It requires humility – the recognition that we are imperfect beings, prone to sin and in need of God’s grace. For it is precisely in our weakness that God’s mercy shines most brightly, transforming our brokenness into a vessel for His love and mercy to flow through (2 Corinthians 12:9).

Scripture is replete with verses that remind us of the depth and breadth of God’s mercy. In Psalm 103:8, we read, “The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.” This verse encapsulates the essence of God’s character – a God who is not quick to anger but instead lavishes us with His unfailing love and compassion. Another poignant example of God’s mercy is found in the story of the

prodigal son (Luke 15:11-32). The parable beautifully illustrates the boundless mercy of our heavenly Father, who is always ready to forgive and restore us, no matter how far we may have strayed. We must therefore be open to receiving God’s abundant mercy.

However, as we open our hearts to receive God’s mercy, we are also called to extend that same mercy to others. In Matthew 5:7, Jesus declares, “Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.” This verse reminds us that as recipients of God’s mercy, we are admonished to extend that same mercy to others. In extending mercy to others, we not only set them free – we set ourselves free as well. We release the burden of bitterness and resentment that weighs us down, and we open ourselves up to the transformational power of God’s love. We become vessels of mercy, channels through which God’s grace flows freely into the world.

We are also invited to follow the example of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska who in her diary, “*Divine Mercy in My Soul*,” teaches the importance of performing acts of mercy with love and compassion. She emphasizes that even the smallest acts of kindness, done with a sincere heart, has the power to bring healing and hope to those in need. Her life serves as a powerful example of how we can live out the message of mercy in our own lives. Through our words and actions, both spiritual and corporal, we can be instruments of God’s mercy and compassion, bringing healing, hope, and reconciliation to a world in need. As we extend a hand of mercy to others, we are transformed, becoming more fully conformed to the image of the resurrected Christ and experiencing the joy and peace that come from living under God’s will.

On this Divine Mercy Sunday, dear beloved parishioners, may we open our hearts to receive the abundant mercy of God, trusting in His unfailing love and compassion. May we also be inspired to share that mercy with all whom we encounter, so that the light of God’s love may shine brightly in our world. May the grace of God’s mercy be with you all.

# Theme: Divine Mercy Sunday

Divine Mercy Sunday Year B, April 7, 2024

First Reading Acts 4:32-35, Second Reading 1 John 5:1-6, Gospel John 20:19-31

Today, the Second Sunday of Easter, we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday instituted By Saint John Paul II in the year 2000. On the institution of the Divine Mercy Sunday, he said, “there is nothing that man needs more than Divine mercy. Apart from the mercy of God there is no other source of hope for mankind.” Today our world needs God’s mercy more than anything else. We need God’s mercy as the world battles with all kinds of political crisis and injustice especially in the war going on in Ukraine. We pray for the Mercy of God to come down like rain from heaven, to bring an end to this war and many other countries where there are crises. We pray for God’s mercy on many families who have lost their loved ones in this war in Ukraine. Many people have been displaced and forced to leave their home and we pray that the mercy of God would bring consolation to them. We cannot forget the military who have been over stretched as a result of this war that they may be encouraged.

The first reading gives a glimpse of the life of early Christian community who live and share communal living. The community living involved reading the Bible, the life of the Saints, Catechism of the Church, and some other books of the early spiritual writers together as one community of believers. Breaking of Bread is what we do every day, especially on Sunday the day of the Lord’s resurrection and this is done in communal form and that is the reason it is important to be present in the Mass physically with other members of the community and not virtually. It also involves pulling all their resources together and distributing them according to people’s need. The idea is to avoid any member of the Christian community being in want while the rest of the community live off their

wealth. This is the genesis of the communal life of religious congregation.

Today’s gospel reading is the same reading every second Sunday of Easter irrespective of the year A, B or C. This is because of the significance of the content of the passage. Peace is the first gift of Jesus after His resurrection from the dead. “Peace be with you.” He said to them. The most amazing thing is that the last time Jesus saw His apostles was when they abandoned Him and ran away. He comes now and offers them His mercy even though they rejected Him when He needed them most. It is a gift, and a blessing Jesus gives to each of us today as we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. Jesus wants each of us to be an agent of mercy and peace.

There is an amazing message from today’s liturgy in the encounter between Jesus and Thomas the Apostle. When he was told by the other apostles that Jesus had risen from the dead and that He had appeared to them he refused to believe and said, “unless I see the mark of the nails in His hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hand into His side, I will not believe.” When finally, Jesus appeared again and told him to bring his hand and put it in His side, Thomas then answered and said, “My Lord and My God.” Let us not doubt the power of God in our lives. Let us believe that Jesus has risen from the dead and He lives among us, and He is always very close and near us. Let us, from today, cast away the Spirit of doubt that makes us lose faith in God and have total faith and trust in the power of the Risen Christ. My prayer for you today is that the gift of peace Jesus gives us at His resurrection will remain in your families so that your families will be a home where peace dwells always. Amen.

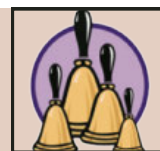

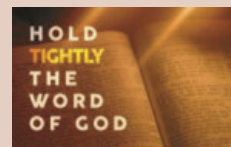
## Pope's Prayer Intentions for April - For the Role of Women

## St. Vincent de Paul Spring Food Drive



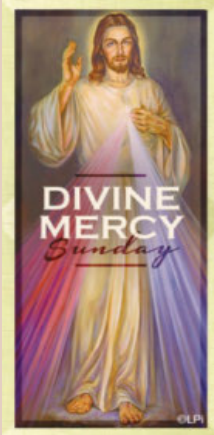
